Hampton Inn, 905 Spence Avenue, Goldsboro, NC 27534, has reserved a block of rooms for April 26, 2013, at a price of \$77.00 per room. Some of the amenities listed are that all rooms have refrigerator, microwave, etc. They have wireless internet in all of the guest rooms as well as a business center with printer access in the lobby. A hot breakfast is served in the lobby from 6:00 a.m. until 10:00 a.m.

If anyone would prefer to stay on base, the Southern Pines Inn, 1234 Wright Brothers Avenue, Seymour Johnson AFB, NC 27534, is available for reservations. Phone number is 919-722-0385.

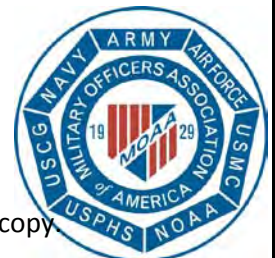

HOTEL RESERVATION INFORMATION

The Eastern Carolina Chapter of MOAA has reserved a block of 25 rooms at the **Hampton Inn located at 905 North Spence Avenue, Goldsboro, NC 27534**. Their telephone number is toll free (888) 761-5267 or (919) 778-1800. They have given us a rate of \$77.00 per room for the night April 26, 2013. If anyone wishes to stay longer, you may request an additional night at the time you make your reservations. They also have an online reservation link for anyone wishing to make their reservations online. You will not be able to talk to a live person, but will be able to make reservations and get a confirmation number. Reservations must be made **NO LATER THAN APRIL 5, 2013**, to get this discounted rate. Each room has either a king bed or two queen beds in it. There is a HOT breakfast offered in the lobby from 6:00 A.M. to 10:00 A.M.

The Saturday morning (April 27, 2013) Council of Chapters meeting will be held in the **Conference Room at Hampton Inn**. The room has been reserved from 7:30 A.M. until 1:30 P.M. There will be water, coffee (both decaf and regular), as well as soft drinks and assorted pastries.

****Directions to the Hotel which is located just off Highway 70 East Bypass in Goldsboro:**

Directions from north-east-west-south directions to get to Goldsboro, and to the hotel. Take the exit for Wal-Mart (Spence Avenue) when you come from either direction. At the stop lights (depending on whether you are coming from the east or west, you will want to turn so that Wal-Mart will be on your left and the Hampton Inn will be on your right just down and across the street from Wal-Mart. Bojangles will be on your right, then Holiday Inn Express, and then Hampton Inn (just back of Applebee's Restaurant).

****Directions to the Goldsboro Country Club where the dinner will be held on Friday night:**

When you leave the hotel, turn right out of the parking lot onto Spence Avenue. Follow Spence Avenue until it dead-ends at **Elm Street** (after approximately 4 stoplights). Turn right on Elm Street, go one block and turn left onto **Stoney Creek Parkway**, follow Stoney Creek Parkway which becomes **Harris Street** once you make the SHARP RIGHT TURN. Follow **Harris Street** for several blocks until you come to a stop light which will be the intersection of **Harris and Slocumb Streets**. Turn left on **Slocumb** and the Goldsboro Country Club is just a short way down Slocumb Street on the right side. Turn right into the parking lot. Entrance is difficult to see until you are right on it.

Interstate 795 from 264 is a new road, but basically the directions listed below are the same unless someone is coming from the North (Rocky Mount, Wilson, etc) and wishes to take I-795 instead of 117 South to Goldsboro.

From Wilmington Area:

Entering The Goldsboro area on 117 N, take the Cherry Hospital exit. Turn left onto Ash Street. Go around the traffic circle and remain on Ash Street. Turn right onto Slocumb Street (beside florist). The Country Club is on the right after the 5th stoplight.

From Fayetteville Area:

If coming into Goldsboro on Hwy 13, turn left on 13N/117N, and follow the above directions.

If coming into Goldsboro via Interstate 95, take Hwy 70E to Goldsboro. Take the Wayne Memorial Hospital exit. Turn right at the top of the exit ramp and stay on this street until it intersects with Ash Street. Turn right onto Ash and then left onto Slocumb Street. The Country Club is on the right after the 5th stoplight.

From New Bern/Kinston Areas:

Entering the Goldsboro area on Hwy 70W, take the Wayne Memorial Hospital exit. Turn left at the top of the exit ramp and stay on this street until it intersects with Ash Street. Turn right onto Ash and then left onto Slocumb Street. The Country Club is on the right after the 5th stoplight.

From Greene County Area:

Take Hwy 13S to Hwy 70W, and follow the above directions.

From the Raleigh Area:

Take Hwy 70 East to Goldsboro. Take 117 South to Cherry Hospital Exit (towards Mt. Olive. Turn right at top of ramp onto Ash Street. Go around the traffic circle and remain on Ash Street. Turn right onto Slocumb Street (beside florist). The Country Club is on the right after the 5th stoplight.

****NOTE: The entrance to the Country Club is somewhat difficult to see.**
